The award was presented for Judy's success in the women's 60 heptathlon event during the year that won a NZ title and was also a NZ record. Thank you to Jim and Colleena Blair for kindly donating the trophy that was presented.

## **SENSHU INTERNATIONAL MARATHON**

### **Japan, 18 February 2001**

I returned from Japan after 11 days subject to the best hospitality the Japanese are famous for. Each year one Wellingtonian is selected to run in this event as part of our sister city relationship with Sakai, one of the organising cities.

The first 3 nights were at an international hotel near the finish line in Osaka. On Sunday we ran the race, after this we spent the night in another plush hotel this time in Sakai. This was followed by 3 nights with a Japanese family (very nice husband and wife with reasonable English who appreciated my attempts at speaking their language). After that I travelled on the bullet train to Hiroshima for a couple of days where once again my accommodation was a Homestay (wife and husband). Whilst in Hiroshima, I visited a very famous Shinto shrine and a Buddhist temple on a very beautiful nearby island - Miyajima, and also the Peace Park situated at the hypocentre of the atomic bomb also visited recently by Helen Clark.

Sakai City's other two invited athletes from their sister cities (in China and USA) and I were well looked after and were shown around some of the local cultural facilities in Sakai and Osaka during the several days we spent with them, including a day trip to Kyoto. I loved the fascinating mix of traditional and modern in all aspects of Japanese life.

The marathon field consisted of 2956 entrants including 266 women (very male dominated) of which a total of 2412 finished. The 1984 Fletcher Marathon field of 2824 finishers, for me the largest field I'd run in would be similar. I know not how many starters they had there but there wasn't any time restriction in finishing there. The highway we ran along was only booked for a certain time. The DNF's were loaded onto the retired runner's buses at designated places along the route. To avoid the free ride to the finish and to collect the T-shirt, runners needed to be ahead of the 4 hour 30 minute deadline and the deadlines at all retired runner areas along the route. I ran a confident 3:44.14 but the American runner invited by Sakai, finished in 4:27.04, was a little concerned.

I've never had to put my hand up to go to the toilet since school days but that changed here. The rule was if you felt the urge during the race you had to raise your right hand when passing a marshal. Not a bush in sight!

For those who voluntarily wished not to complete the run, they were to cross their hands to the marshalls.

All runners were requested to fully demonstrate their refined marathon runner spirits. I'm not sure what that involved but I was on my best behaviour.
